World TB Day Celebration

Tuberculosis is a highly infectious bacterial disease caused by the bacterium *Mycobacterium Tuberculosis*. It can affect any part of the body, when it affects the lungs then it is called Pulmonary TB, when it affects other part of the body (i.e. other than lungs) called extra pulmonary TB. Fever, night sweat, pain in chest, weight loss, loss of appetite, cough (more than 2 weeks), swelling of lymph nodes are the main symptoms of TB. It mainly transmits from person to person by coughing & sneezing (i.e. Droplet Transmission). Government of India has committed to end TB by 2025. So on the occasion of World TB day, we arranged a sensitization programme by a Walkathon Rally at Adesing Village, under Sagada GP, with a theme of “Yes We Can! End TB”, and create an awareness among the villagers with a slogan “TB HATAO, DESA BANCHAO” and discussed about the sign and symptom, mode of transmission, testing & medication facilities. In the said programme ASHA, AWW, Sri Ramakanta Sahu (STS TB, CHC Baunsuni), Ramesh Kumar Jena (Secretary, CHANDRAMA) says very valuable words to the villagers.



Skill Development Training programme

Education is the Transmission of knowledge, skill, Behavior, Empathy, Respect and Character traits and manifests in various forms. Among the forms skill is the play vital role for the students. Skill development at the school stage offers a wide range of benefits to students, educators, and society as a whole. These benefits extend beyond academic knowledge and play a crucial role in personal and professional growth which include. CHANDRAMA focusing on improvement of primary education in accessibility area of sagada G.P of Boudh Block. So CHANDRAMA using many types of technique like-By Playing, Drawing, debate, song, quiz, competition through this the students are interest to study in accessibility community. Dated on 16.03.2024 CHANDRAMA have organize a Drawing competition for the Adesing community Students. In the said programme organize in presence of all community people ASHA, AWW, CHANDRAMA staffs and lastly Sri Ramesh Kumar Jena (Secretary, CHANDRAMA) says very valuable words to the villagers.



Eye Camp

CHANDRAMA is working in the field of Health, Education and Livelihood. Among them Health is an important aspect of living society. In exigency of public service CHANDRAMA decided to arrange a computerised free eye Checkup camp. So in collaboration with Mahanadi Netra Chikitsalaya, Pandapali, B. M Pur, Sonepur on date 07.Nov.2023, 128 no of patient were checkup their eye and among them 49 no were identified with cataract, and they gone to MNC, Pandapali for cataract surgery. Similarly on date 11. March.2024, 54 number of patient registered and checkup their eye and 10 number of patient identified with cataract and gone for MNC, Pandapali, for surgery.



Blood donation Camo

Blood donation is a noble act that should be done by a healthy person to save someone life. Based on the belief CHANDRAMA a voluntary organization had organized this event at Chandrama Conference hall, Jamatangi, Boudh On 28.2.2024 collected 31units of Bloods with active support from the Blood Bank Boudh .We are very much thankful to the above dignitaries, also the Blood donor and all members of CHANDRAMA.



WINTER CLOTHES DISTRIBUTION

A major part of Odisha is known for its chilling winters which shakes everyone. There are many of people without winter cloths in winter. live in open without proper clothes, It is very difficult for them to combat with the winter without such a scenario. To help them, our organization, initiated winter drive, in which staff and volunteers distributed woollen clothes to needy people. During this year CHANDRAMA distributed the winter clothes in four phases in four villages like- Nalikumpa, Nelijodi, Jodasingh, Adsing, are coming under Sagada Gram panchayat, Boudh block .

CHNADRAMA organized a Mushroom Cultivation Training program for 30 Self Help Group (SHG) individuals on 06.02.2024. The program aimed to provide basic knowledge in mushroom cultivation, sustainable resource use, self-employment, and practical experience. The training aimed to understand various aspects of cultivation, cropping patterns, and pest disease management. Mushroom cultivation can generate employment, provide livelihood opportunities for rural women and youth, and increase economic standards by selling, harvested, fruiting bodies in local markets or exporting them.



Road Safety Week

Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Government of India is observing the Road Safety Week from 11th to 17th January 2024, Accordingly we have observe the same period by our organization. Road traffic safety is the methods and measures used to prevent road users include pedestrians, cyclists, motorists, vehicle passengers, and passengers of on-road public transport ,mainly buses and other vehicles. On behalf of our organization, we have been organized Road safety Program on a regular basis to aware them for their safety from any type of road accident. We have observed the road safety week at Jamatangi maket in presence of 72 no of peoples

Here competition like- Drawing, General knowledge, Debate has been arranged by CHANDRAMA for the skill development as well as the entertainment.



Street light Distribution

CHANDRAMA always stand for the poorest of the people, weaker section and vulnerable section of the society. Godavanga is a very tinny village coming under Manupali G. P. During night, when light cutoff their is zero face to face vison. So in collaboration with the Village Development Commitee (VDC) of that village, five number of street light were fitted. Finally the villagers were very happy and thankful to CHANDRAMA.



Diabetic Day

The Diabetic is a non-communicable disease which is very dangerous, when the level of sugar in blood increases to normal level it may be life threatening. World Diabetic Day has been observed on 14 November 2024 by our organization at Rugudikanpa, under Sagada GP. In this program Miss Haripriya Pradhan, CHO Rugudikanpa, AWW, ASHA, all community people and Assistance secretary of CHANDRAMA are present in this programme, 40 number of diabetic people were attended the programme. The expert CHO madam discussed the causes of diabetic and how to combat it. This becomes a huge helpful program for the participants.

Grass Root Level Training Programme

Self –help Group (SHGs) are informal associations people who come together to find ways to improve their living condition .They are generally self governed and peer-controlled. People of similar economic and social background associate generally with the help of any NGO or Government agency and try resolve their issues and improve their living condition. NABARD is formed the SHG Bank Linkage project which is today the world's largest micro finance project. from 1993 NABARD along with the Reserve Bank in India allowed SHGs to open saving bank accounts in bank.

They are try to build the functional capacity of poor and marginalized section of the society in the domain of employment activities and collateral free loan to poor sections of the people that generally find it hard to get loans from bank. Self help group members reach a point where they could not graduate to the next level of entrepreneurship due to various reasons such as lack of financial literacy, requisite management skills, technical knowledge, market linkage value addition for their products & service adequate supply of credit, change in the government's policy etc.

It is concluded that majority of the self help group leaders are in low of knowledge in most of these as. But after attending training programme their knowledge have improved considerably .So CHANDRAMA arrange frequent training programme Exclusively for women self help group leaders. Leadership is a gift that requires you to set a direction ,motivate, inspire, and develop others, and deliver result that matter .it ia also journey, it is about experience and the influence yo have on others.



Livelihood Promotion Activities

Livelihood interventions are conscious efforts by CHANDRAMA to promote and support livelihood opportunities for Self help Group(SHG) Individual Farmers they are those directly employed them . On behalf of our effort we have started various livelihood promotion efforts like- Agriculture. Many types of Vegetables, Mushroom Cultivation.



Swachha Bharat Mission

Our organization members and the volunteers are actively involved for local area cleanliness program under 'Swachha Bharat Abhiyan'. This is our ongoing activities in Jodasing, Manupali, Adsing, and Gudubhanga. Clean to keep the people disease free & personal hygiene. It creates an awareness among the communities towards sanitization and cleanness.



Bana Mahotsava

The environment degradation is a global problem as on today. We have been aware the children regarding environmental issues through drawing and writing too as part of the event. So on this occasion CHANDRAMA with the help of 48 community members planted 15000 Fasi tree as a part of Jagannath Banaprakalpa. This activity support from Radheshyam Kampa Kuaghara , and other staff of forest office and local community people and members of CHANDRAMA.

Also throughout the year, we have been organized Yoga camp in our organization under an expert Yoga instructor. Malaria is a vector born disease, it occurs on biting of Female Anopheles Mosquito. As Boudh district is a hub of Malaria Disease and some death also declared due to the disease. So on the occasions of World Malaria Day, we arranged a rally from Adesing village to Chanher villiage under Sagada GP, and aware the people through street play (PALA), and demonstrate that how to use mosquito nets, meeting etc. Door to door RDK testing and use of mosquito nets should be checked. In the said programme Dr. Rajib Naik (BPHO), MTS Malaria, BPM CHC, Baunsuni, Ramesh Kumar Jena, Ramachandra Meher (Secretary & President, CHANDRAMA) are present in the meeting and create an awareness among the people.
